Show and Tell: Choose any one favorite toy (car, doll, ball, drum, bunny, etc) and let your child speak few lines on it. The lines will be shared by the class teacher.

Show and Tell activity will be conducted in the month of July.

Life Skills Activities:

1. Table Lay Out: From putting a napkin in their lap to clearing their plate off the table and everything in between, the child should learn the table manners.
2. Be a folding helper: Take help from mum to fold your clothes and become a folding helper at home.
3. Fresh squeezed lemonade: Squeeze the lemons, add some syrup and mix the lemonade. Serve it to your parents and grandparents to beat the summer heat.



Gross Motor Skills Activities:

1. Fun Hand Games: Try out some fun hand games with your elders like Thumb wrestling, hand clapping games etc.
2. Water Transfer with Sponge: For this activity follow the directions below:
 1. Fill one container with water and setup other containers adjacent to it.
 2. Dip sponges into the water until they are saturated.
 3. Carry sponge to empty bucket and “squeeeeee” all the water out.
 4. Repeat until you’ve moved all the water out of its original container.

3. Walk like an animal: run, stretch and experience the animal walks.

Step2 Paint the center with the color for the face and let it dry. Then paint the hair;



















Step3 Trace and cut out the moustache and bowtie templates. You can also draw this
