Shade 7 parts out of 10 so as to represent 0.7 as shown below:-






Type 1:

Deep inside the ocean, sunlight can hardly reach ,yet plants such as brown and red algae are found here.

(a) How do you think they are able to live there?







- (b) Can plant use artificial source of light (for example, tube light) for preparing food?
- (c) Name the pigments responsible for photosynthesis in brown and red algae.

Type 2:

Three jars A, B and C are taken. Jar A is half-filled with tap water. Jar B is half-filled with water which was boiled for a few minutes. Jar C is half-filled with the same boiled water as in jar B. In all the three jars, an iron nail is dropped. In jar C, after the addition of the iron nail, some oil is added so that a film covers the surface of water. The jars are kept for and opened after 10 days, the nail in jar A is completely rusted, the nail in jar B is slightly rusted; while; the nail in jar C has not rusted at all.

- (a) What is rusting?
- (b) What are the factors responsible for rusting?
- (c) Why the nail in jar C has not rusted at all while nail in Jar A was completely rusted?
- (d) Suggest some methods to prevent rusting.

- 1. **Assertion**: Plants make their food themselves and are called autotrophs **Reason**: Human Beings and other animal depend on plant for their food
- 2. **Assertion**: Some Bacteria are present in root nodules of leguminous plants.

Reason: Leguminous plants have nodulated roots

- 3. **Assertion**: The small intestine is about 7.5m long and highly coiled **Reason**: It is smaller as compared to large intestine
- 4. **Assertion**: Rumen is the first of four chambers of stomach of ruminants **Reason**: In rumen the food get partly digested and is called cud.
- 5. Assertion: Digestion in Amoeba is intracellular

Reason: In the food vacuole the food becomes trapped and is digested by the action of digestive juices secreted into vacuole.

6. **Assertion**: A physical property can be identified without bringing any chemical change

Reason: Chemical changes takes place through chemical reactions.







7. **Assertion**: Tearing of paper is a physical change, although it cannot be reversed. **Reason**: Chemical change is a reaction involving the change in chemical properties

or composition, resulting in the formation of a new substance.

8. **Assertion**: Burning of a candle is a physical change.

Reason: The products formed by burning a candle cannot be easily converted back to original candle.

9. **Assertion**: Breaking of a bone china plate is a physical change.

Reason: When a bone china plate breaks, the pieces cannot be joined to get back the original plate.

10. **Assertion:** Digestion of carbohydrate, like starch, begins in buccal cavity **Reason**: The digested food is absorbed in the blood vessels from small intestine


